

The Conference will be held at Collegio Cairoli in Pavia, an ancient historical University College dating back to the XVIII century and located in the center of the town.



HISTORICAL INFORMATION

Founded by Giuseppe II of Austria in 1781 and opened in 1783 as “Germanic-Hungarian College Board” for theology students, it occupied the unfinished building of S. Francis Monastery. Closed by the General Bonaparte in 1796, it was turned into a post exchange until 1947, when the Military property office gave it to the University of Pavia so that it could be reopened as college board. Officially inaugurated in 1948 as “Collegio Fratello Cairoli”, at first it was run directly by the University, then by the Opera Universitaria e finally by the ISU of the University of Pavia.
