For text, figures or tables please prepare the supplementary material as one single PDF file, and submit the supplementary material separately from the rest of the manuscript.

The Supplementary material reference is inserted after the Acknowledgments section in the main paper. It should be in the form of:

IMPORTANT NOTE: The supplementary material is not edited by the journal. Great care should therefore be taken by you, the author, in preparing the file and in following these instructions.

In particular, authors should ensure: (1) all legends/captions are informative, and are labelled correctly and cited in the text (e.g. Appendix 1, Table A1, Fig. A2), (2) the data presented are accurate, (3) text is grammatically correct, (4) the journal style is followed, including additional references.

There will be no opportunity to edit your Supplementary material once published online; thus the last version supplied will be the one published. No changes at all can be made after this.
